As a part of this series the Department of Commerce organised a special session on the topic "**building human capital-education, health and happiness**" on 21<sup>st</sup>, January, 2020. The distinguished speakers for the day were Dr Sushma Yadav, Vice Chancellor of Bhagat Phool Singh Mahila Vishwavidyalaya and Dr Yamini Gupt, Deputy Dean International Relations (Social Science and Humanities) at the University of Delhi.

Dr. Sushma Yadav talked on health being the most important parameter and emphasized on anaemia in girls and also discussed about human capital as it is recognized as core and contributing factor in social development and capital formation. She also put forward the importance of home makers who is not engaged in any occupation but also contribute to the development of human capital as it nurtures human and maintain homes.

Dr. Yamini Gupt carried forward the session to brief the audience about biodiversity and it's link with human capital. The problem of destruction of natural habitat by the people for their own use was also discussed. The major reason for the depress growth of human capital is excess spread of diseases. She further explained that in order to increase the wellbeing and future productivity of workers, more investment and attention is required in health sector.
