ELECTORAL LITERACY CLUB

An Electoral Literacy Club is a platform to engage students through interesting activities and hands-on experience to sensitise them on their electoral rights and familiarise them with the electoral process of registration and voting. Electoral literacy and performance of electoral duties has always been undertaken by the college.

The ELC has representatives from among all stakeholders and the composition of the core committee is as follows:

- 1. Since the NSS has in the past conducted electoral literacy, the NSS Programme Officer will in addition to her PO duties, be the Coordinator of the ELC and three NSS students nominated by the PO will be a part of the core team.
- 2. Since the NCC too has conducted electoral literacy awareness activities, the Caretaker/ANO will be a faculty member of the Club and three NCC cadets will be nominated by her to be a part of the core team
- 3. The two Administrative officers ,DrKaushal Kishore and MrSurendra Kumar will be the Staff representatives of the Club

The duties of the Club will involve:

- 1. Voluntary contribution by the students in electoral processes
- 2. Participation in voter registration of students and communities where they come from assisting district election administration in conduct of poll
- 3. Voter awareness campaigns
- 4. Promotion of ethical voting
- 5. Enhancing participation of the under privileged sections of society especially transgender, commercial sex workers, disabled persons, senior citizens, etc.
- 6. Undertaking socially relevant projects/initiatives in electoral related issues especially research projects, surveys, awareness drives, creating content, publications highlighting contribution to advancing democratic values and participation in electoral processes, etc.
- 6. Facilitating enrolment of students above 18 years who are yet to be enrolled as voters in the electoral roll and making efforts to institutionalize mechanisms to register eligible students as voters.
