Objectives of the event:	Our aim in organizing the workshop, in collaboration with Ekang, was to foster creativity and self-reliance through the art of candle making. The workshop provided a platform for participants to learn practical skills while acquiring profound knowledge about creative entrepreneurship.

Brief Report

The Incubation Program of Janki Devi Memorial College, organized a Candle Making Workshop on 5th April between 12:00 p.m. and 3:00 p.m. in the auditorium. It was conducted with great success among 14 eager participants. The workshop began with an introduction to Ekang and the incubation program. The team members of Ekang then introduced themselves and gave insights into their innovative venture.

The team of Ekang gave them a step-by-step demonstration of the jar cleaning, wick fixing, melting the wax, adding the fragrance and color, and pouring the wax. Participants were given wristbands and introduced to candle-making materials.

The procedure was thoroughly explained to small groups so that each step was clear. All participated actively in the process, selecting the preferred scents and creatively decorating their candles with different accessories. The activity was interactive, and participants asked questions and participated in the hands-on process.

We observed this activity as a platform for budding artists to express their creativity. Moving forward, we look forward to showcasing such work under Anupam Haat as part of the Program's Skill Enhancement Training initiative.





Workshop on AI and Automation in Digital Marketing

Objectives of the event:	The workshop aimed to introduce students to the growing role of AI and automation in digital marketing. It focused on practical tools and strategies to optimize digital marketing efforts, improve efficiency, and leverage AI for career growth. Participants learned about AI-powered marketing strategies, automation tools, and the future scope of AI-driven job markets.

Brief Report

The Incubation Program of Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi, organized a workshop on Artificial Intelligence & Automation in Digital Marketing on 15 February 2025 between 11:00 AM and 1:30 PM in the Seminar Room. There were about a 100 students present,

who were interested in learning about how AI is changing the behavior of businesses towards customers and marketing optimization.

The session started with an engaging discussion on how AI has transformed traditional customer service jobs, with 80% of past call center roles now replaced by AI-powered chatbots and virtual assistants. Panelists spoke about voice marketing, explaining how AI-driven voice assistants are becoming an essential part of customer interaction. They also introduced students to Instagram AI influencers, who are now shaping buying decisions through highly personalized content recommendations.

The panelists introduced a variety of AI-powered tools that are making marketing smarter and more effective:

- Google Trends A tool that helps businesses identify trending topics and headlines to create content that resonates with their audience.
- Keyword Comparison & Location-Based Search Essential for businesses targeting specific markets, ensuring their marketing reaches the right people at the right time.
- Instant Data Scraper Helps businesses gather and analyze search trends, such as finding the best locations for certain services (e.g., "flower shop near me").
- Chatbots for Business Growth AI-powered chatbots that automate customer interactions, improving service and increasing efficiency.
- LinkedIn Optimization AI tools that help individuals enhance their professional presence and expand networking opportunities in the job market.

The workshop was highly interactive, encouraging students to ask questions and engage in meaningful discussions. Some of the key topics that came up included the future of AI in digital marketing, the impact of automation on jobs, and how students can prepare for AI-driven careers. The panelists shared real-world case studies to help students understand how AI is already transforming businesses and what they can do to stay relevant in the industry.

Feedback

The feedback on the workshop was extremely positive. Students enjoyed the hands-on approach and practical insights, as they were able to try out actual AI tools rather than theoretical ones. Faculty members also recognized the significance of AI education, as they understood how crucial it is for students to remain competitive in an AI-oriented job market. Most of the participants showed interest in learning more about career opportunities based on AI and how they can begin incorporating these tools into their own practice.

Every day, beginning at 10 a.m., the stalls were set up on the dusty ground of the college. More than 1,500 visitors attended the three-day event. Bakery items, crochet products, resin art, handmade candles, face painting, games were showcased. The main highlight of the stall was sugar free cookies, laphing and BYOP, The energetic atmosphere invigorated participants. They enthusiastically enjoyed shopping each day. A survey was also conducted in which people filled their concerns and expectations regarding the stall.

<u>Day 1:</u> More than 300 visitors attended the grand opening of Anupam Haat, delighting in the stall brimming with baked goods, sophisticatedly crocheted items, exquisite resin art, handcrafted candles and energetic face painting. The energetic energy created a solid foundation for the event and enthusiastic shopper participation consistently drew a large crowd all day.

Participants were satisfied with the event and valued the content, but several mentioned that, if given a choice, they would have preferred an in-person format. They noted that in-person events provide a more immersive experience, better engagement opportunities, and more effective networking.


