1. ACTIVITIES CONDUCTED BY DEPARTMENT/CENTRE/CELL/CLUB/SOCIETY

DEPARTMENTS

- **Commerce Department** organised *Comtalk'26*, the annual flagship event, on March 17, 2026, on the theme **seminar** titled *NeoVyaapaar: Connect, Create, Commerce*.
