### **Brief Report:**

The Department of Human Development and Family Empowerment in collaboration with Electoral Literacy Club under the ageis of IQAC and Mera Pehla Vote Desh ke liye Campaign organized a discussion on 'My First Vote: Role of Youth in Democracy' on 12th March, 2024.

The discussion highlighted various aspects surrounding the significance of voting. Foremost among the topics discussed was the pivotal role of obtaining a voter ID, seen as the crucial initiation into exercising one's democratic rights. Participants underscored the necessity of this initial step, recognizing it as the gateway to active participation in the democratic process.

Additionally, the students discussed the strong feeling of civic duty and involvement that comes with voting. They agreed that voting is more than just a right—it is a crucial responsibility in supporting democracy. They all believed that each vote represents a person's voice and position, helping to shape the overall decisions made by the community and government.

In a society where young people's voices are becoming more important, students acknowledged, how powerful they can be together in making social and political changes happen. They strongly emphasized the need for being well-informed, involved, and taking action in elections. They were very passionate about the idea that by being actively involved, they could make a big difference in their communities and country, leaving a lasting impact on how things are done politically and socially.






