and joyous measures.

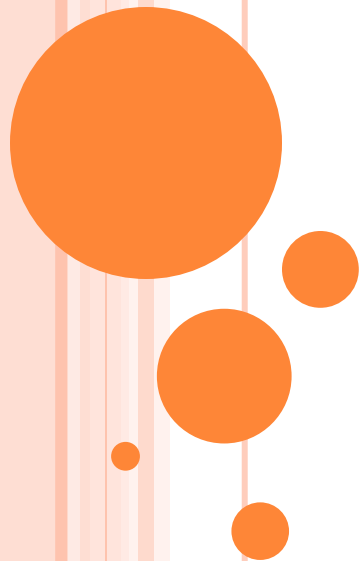




Launch of Radian-ce

Mr. Sandeep Maheshwari,

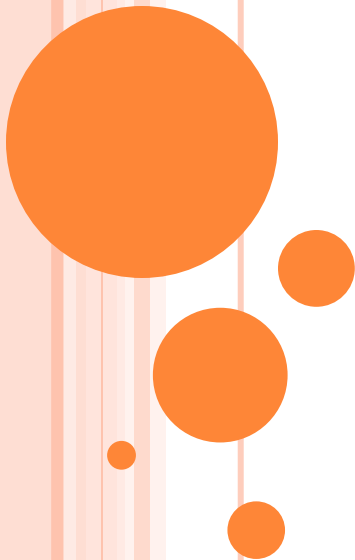
a renowned

minds and calm the mental fury.





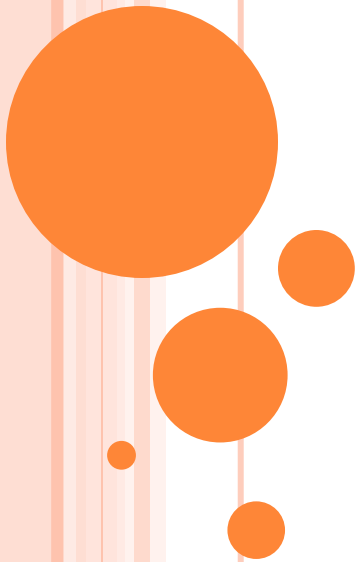
Educational Excursion

on 31st October, 2015

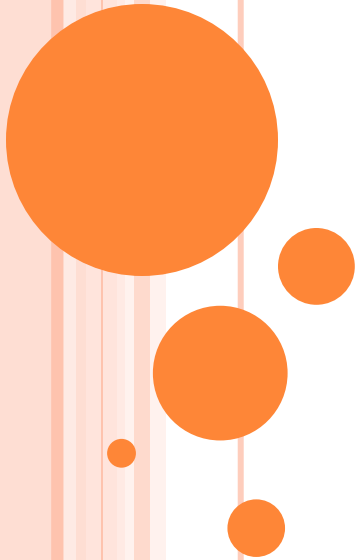
so that their ideas are guided by

faculty members.







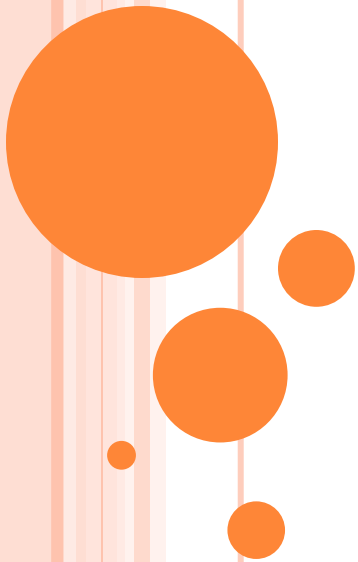
Symphony - 2016

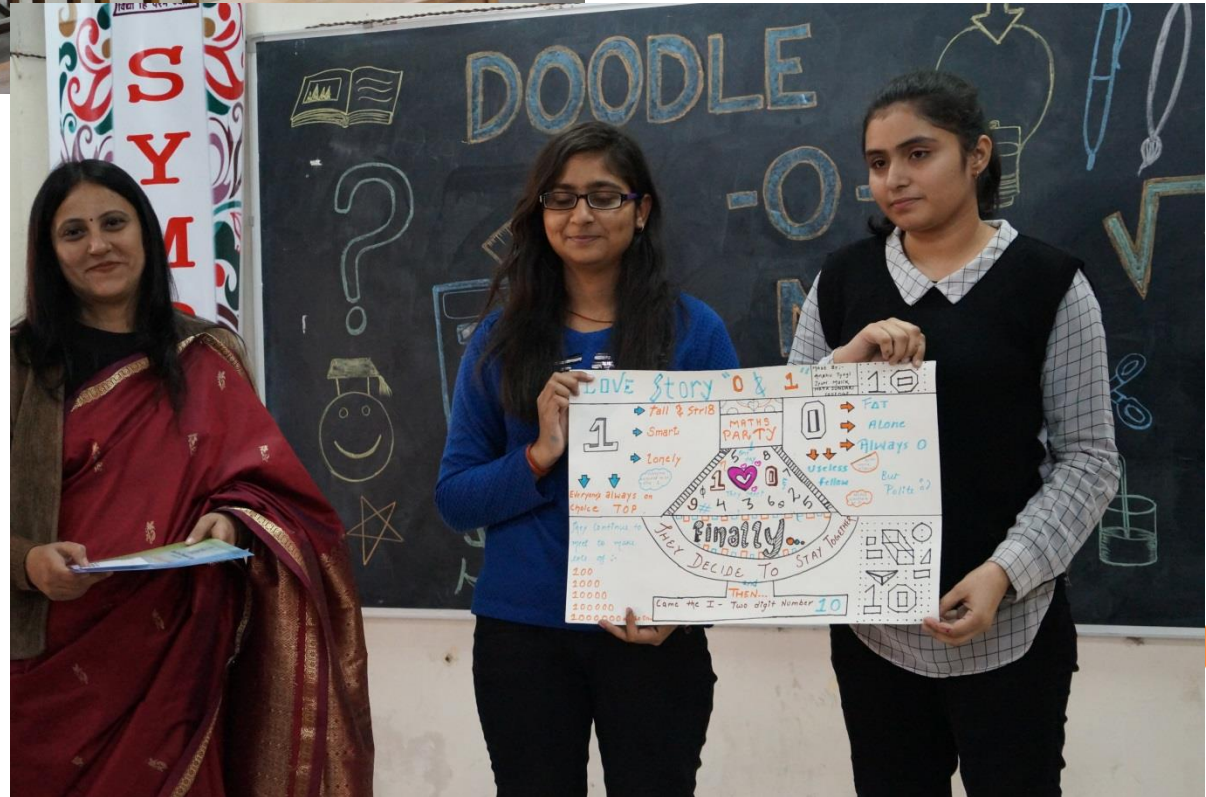
In the Annual Cultural Festival

and dexterity.

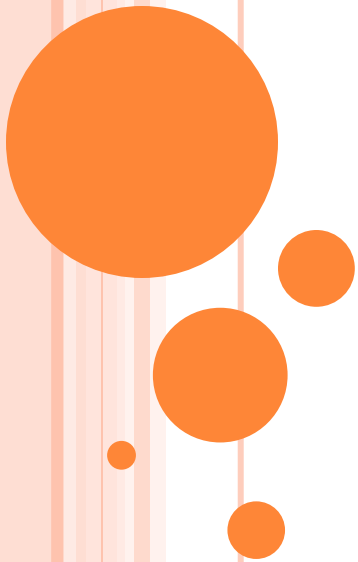


A test of logic and wit

from the city.



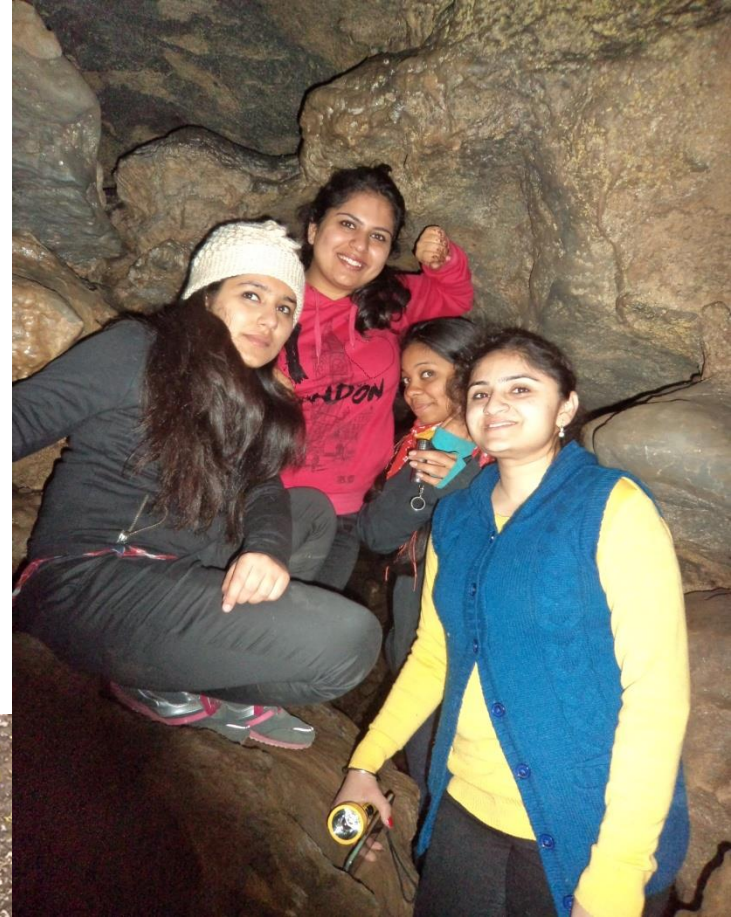


The woods gave way to open meadows,

was something that words can't describe.

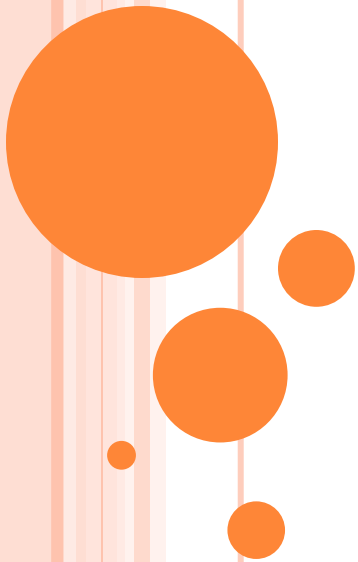
The trip not only brought each traveler

and IQ, respectively.

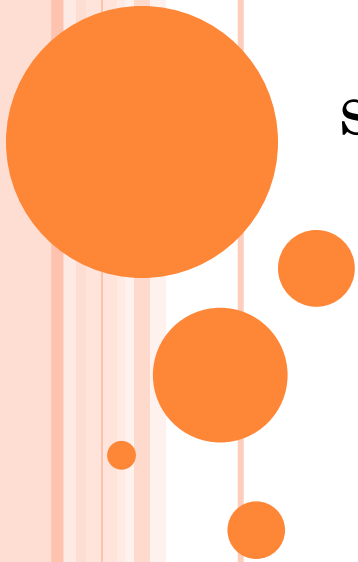






Scribble Day

moments of their college life.

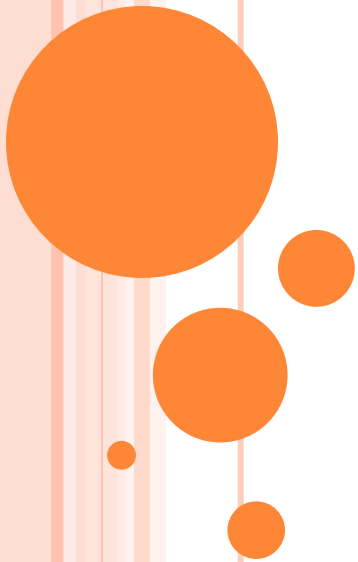






Departmental Farewell
