Brief Report of the session:





Brief Report of the session:

The Sanskrit Department of Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi, conducted a session on *Research Guidelines for Fourth-Year Students* on 6 November 2025. Dr. Harsh Bala, Teacher-in-Charge (TIC) of the department, along with Dr. Jyoti, Association In-Charge, and Dr. Manisha, faculty member of the Sanskrit Department, were present for the event.

During the session, Dr. Harsh Bala guided the students on the essential components of fourth-year research, including the importance of systematic planning, methodological understanding, and academic discipline. They were advised that selecting a suitable topic, critically reviewing existing literature, adhering to ethical research practices, and presenting findings effectively are key to producing high-quality research that demonstrates their preparedness for advanced academic or professional pursuits.

Dr. Jyoti updated the students on the submission timeline, total marks, and assessment scheme. The participants found the session highly beneficial, particularly for the clarity it provided regarding the schedule and evaluation process.

Brief Report of the event:

The Departments of Philosophy and Sanskrit of **Janki Devi Memorial College (University of Delhi)**, under the **IQAC**, organized a seminar on **“POSH Act: Challenge the System That Keeps the Women Down”** on **4th November 2025** in the **Seminar Room at 12:00 PM.**

The guest speaker, **Prof. Dr. Namita Rajput** from **Sri Aurobindo College**, spoke about the **Prevention of Sexual Harassment (POSH) Act, 2013** and how it helps ensure women’s

safety at workplaces. She discussed how sexual harassment is linked to patriarchy and power imbalance, and emphasized the importance of awareness and sensitivity in addressing it.

Dr. Rajput also explained key **IPC sections (354A–354D)** related to sexual offences, the formation of **Internal Complaints Committees (ICCs)**, and the connection between the POSH Act and international conventions like **CEDAW**. The seminar helped students understand the legal framework and the role each individual plays in promoting equality and respect at work.

Janki Devi Memorial College, Counselling committee in collaboration with the Hindi and Sanskrit Department under the aegis of IQAC organized a workshop on “Navigating Stress and Anxiety: Tools for a Healthier Mind” on 10th October 202 from 12.00 pm onwards in room no 17. The new counsellor and psychologist Ms. Himanshi Sahni was introduced to the students by the convenor of the Counselling Committee Prof. Poonam Kanwal.

The workshop “*Navigating Stress and Anxiety: Tools for a Healthier Mind*” was conducted for the students of the Hindi and Sanskrit Departments to increase awareness of mental health and provide practical ways to manage everyday challenges.

The session introduced students to the concepts of stress and anxiety and helped them understand how these show up in daily life. Through discussion and reflection, participants were able to differentiate between common experiences of pressure, worry, and tension, and learn how these affect both the mind and body.

A key focus of the workshop was on coping. Students were introduced to simple techniques such as grounding, breathing, and muscle relaxation, which they practiced together in a fun and interactive way. These exercises gave them first-hand experience of how quickly the body and mind can calm down with the right tools.

The session also encouraged students to reflect on their own experiences and identify their personal signs of stress and anxiety. Towards the end, participants created a “Coping Kit”, a collection of strategies they could turn to whenever they felt overwhelmed. This included practical ideas for supporting the mind, relaxing the body, creating a soothing environment, and reaching out for support.

By the conclusion of the workshop, students reported feeling more confident in recognizing stress and anxiety and better prepared to handle them. The session helped normalize these experiences while offering clear, accessible strategies to respond to them.

Overall, the workshop was interactive, informative, and empowering, leaving participants with valuable tools to take forward in their everyday lives.

Brief Report:



The seminar addressed India’s low environmental performance, the impact of urbanization on health, and issues such as hunger, pollution, and ecological vulnerability, especially among women.
