



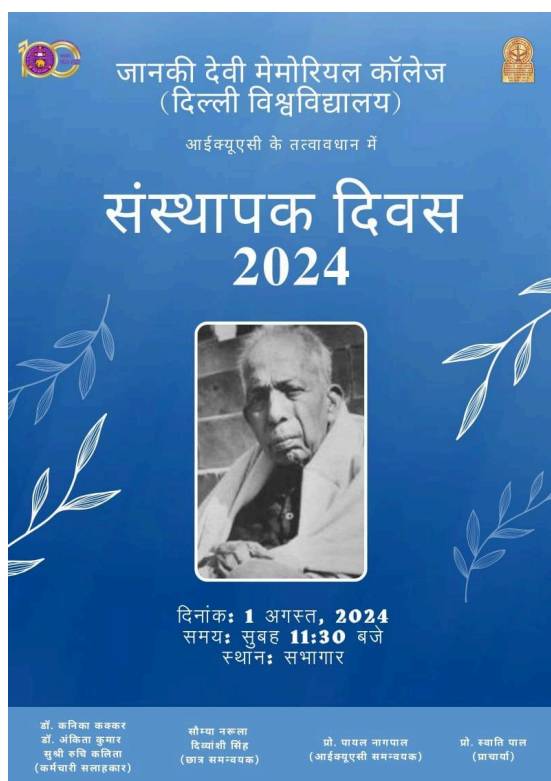
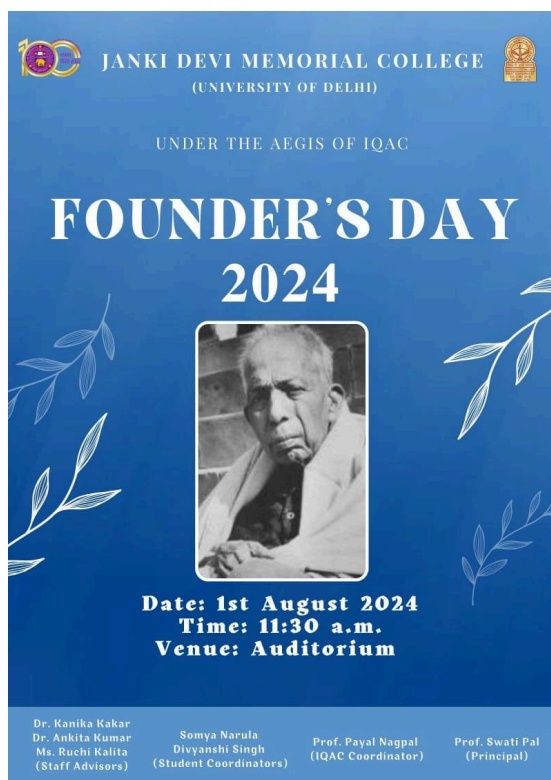

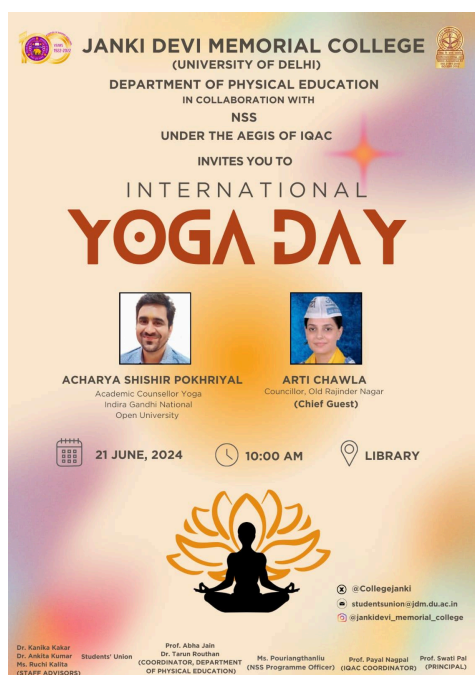

10th International Yoga Day 2024

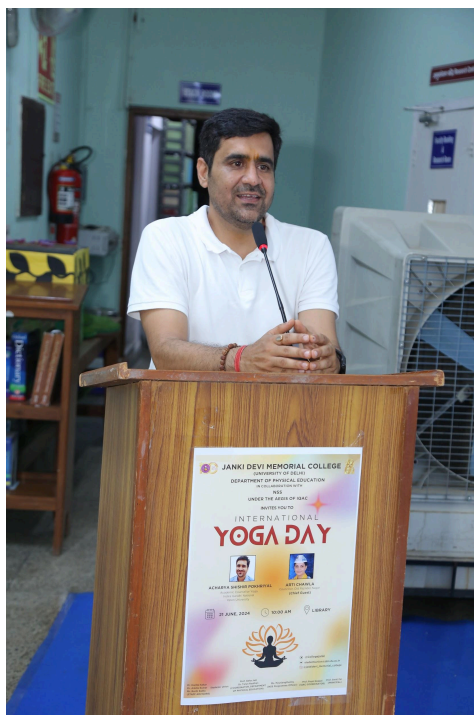

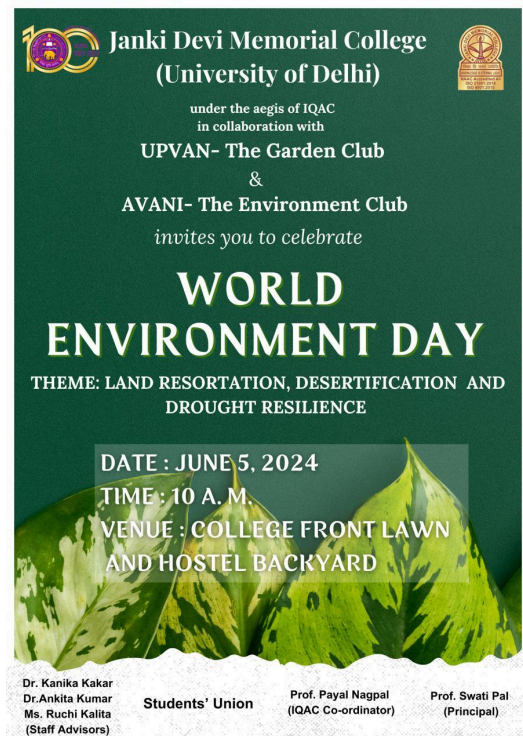
