



Memorandum of Understanding (MoU)

Between

Janki Devi Memorial College,
University of Delhi, Delhi, India

And

Sherubtse College,
Royal University of Bhutan,
Trashigang, Bhutan

Janki Devi Memorial College, University of Delhi, Delhi, India and Sherubtse College, Royal University of Bhutan, Trashigang, Bhutan hereinafter referred to as **"the parties"**

Desiring to establish collaborative relations between the two parties to promote friendship and to co-operate in a mutually beneficial association;

Have reached the following understanding:

Areas of Cooperation and Collaboration

1. The two parties shall encourage co-operation in any discipline studied in both institutions.
2. The two parties shall seek to promote:
 - a. Exchange of information and academic materials that are of mutual interest
 - b. Exchange between the two parties relating to:
 - academic faculty and administrative staff
 - research staff
 - Visiting Scholars
 - Students
 - Other staff mutually agreed upon
 - c. Provision of briefing/orientation services by each party for visitors from the other parties.
 - d. Other forms of co-operation which the two parties may jointly arrange.
3. Details of any such activities will be subject to a subsequent detailed separate Agreement that will be mutually entered into and will be attached to this MoU as an annexure.
 - a. The two parties shall decide through consultation the specific areas and details of co-operation within the framework of this MoU and shall consult from time to time, at the request of either institution, to review the operation of this MoU.
 - b. The financial arrangements involved in the implementation of this MoU shall be settled through consultation between the two parties in respect of each program of co-operation for which a separate Agreement shall be signed after obtaining appropriate approval from the relevant competent authorities of each party.

Validity

4. This MoU will be valid for Five (5) years with an option to renew for a similar period. The parties shall confer concerning the renewal of this MoU six (6) months before the date of expiration

Termination

5. The MoU may be terminated by either party, at any time, by giving six (6) months prior notice in writing to the other parties. The rights and liabilities of the parties concerning any ongoing project/training/exchanges shall remain unaffected by the termination. The same shall be completed as if no such termination has taken place.

Amendment

6. This MoU may be amended by mutual consent of the parties in writing and supplemented by detailed subsequent agreement between the two parties. Amendments and or supplements will be appended as an annexure. For conditions not covered by this MoU, or for problems that arise during this MoU, both parties undertake to refrain from unilateral action and to consult and negotiate mutually acceptable decisions.

Dispute Settlement


7. Any dispute regarding the interpretation or application of this MoU will be resolved through mutual consultations between the Parties and based on the principles of mutual understanding and respect.


Commencement
