Role of Lorenz Curves:

- Lorenz curves represent cumulative income distribution.
- The four principles align with Lorenz curve rankings of inequality.
- However, when Lorenz curves cross, these principles cannot make a clear inequality judgment.

Complete Measures of Inequality:

- Measures assign numerical values to income distributions, creating complete rankings.
- Examples studied include the range, Gini coefficient, mean absolute deviation, coefficient of variation, and Gini coefficient.

Gini coefficient and coefficient of variation: Align with Lorenz principles but may disagree when Lorenz curves cross.

Real-World Observations:

- Numerical and real-life examples, including studies of Latin American inequality, show discrepancies between measures when Lorenz curves cross.
