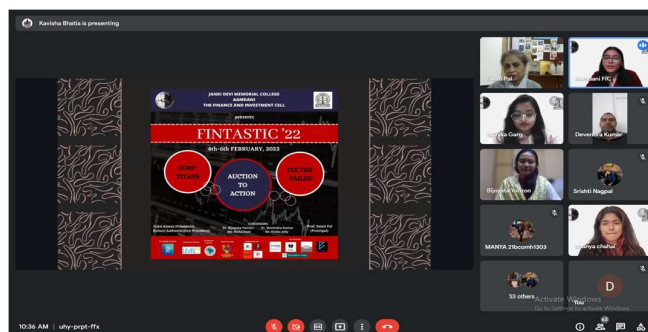

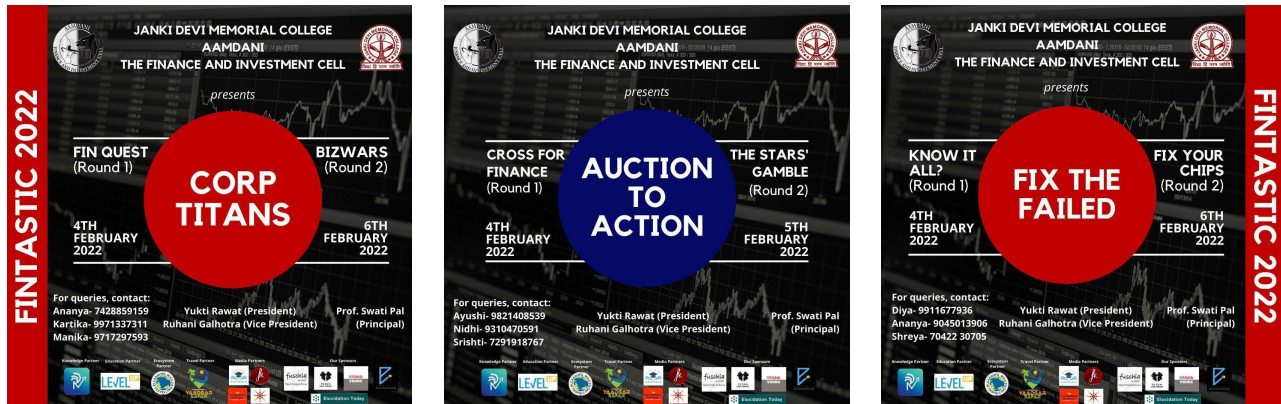
OPENING CEREMONY

THE THREE EVENTS OF FINTASTIC'22

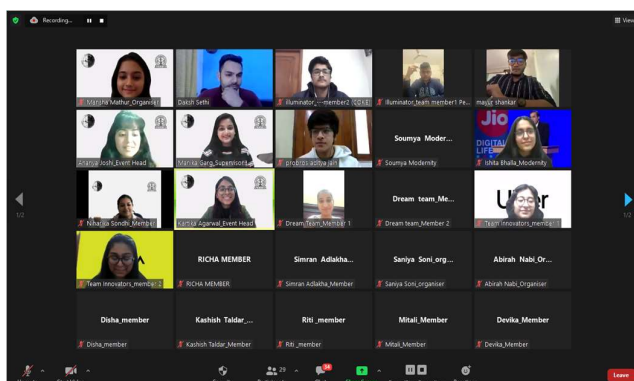

The event started with an explanation of the rules for round 1. The teams were given 30

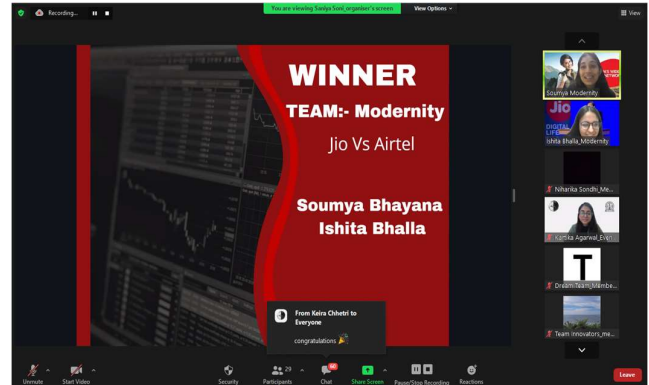

2nd prize- Team Innovators (Ola Vs Uber)

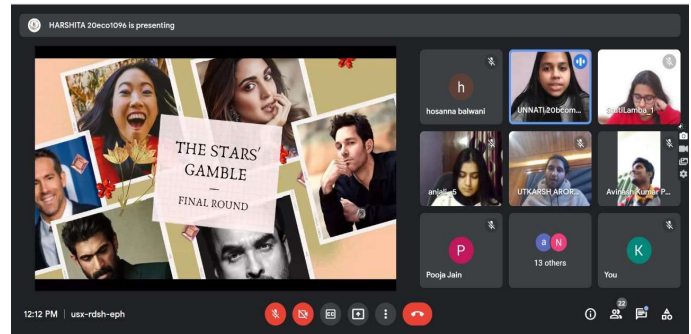
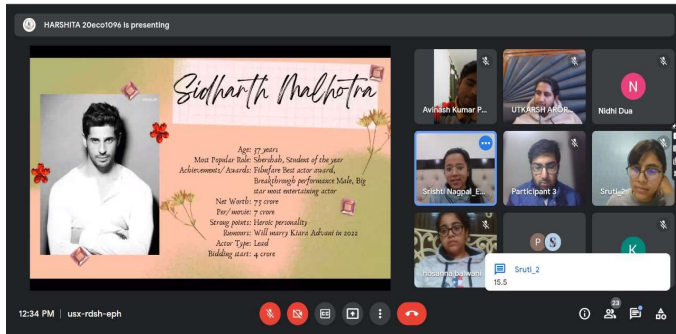

The teams were divided into one contestant each who was to go head-on in a fun roast with the other. Each team had 7 minutes each to prove who was the better one. Contestants were properly prepared and roasted each other with facts and their wits. While the results were being evaluated, a fun game of 'Guess the Gibberish' was planned to keep the audience engaged and interested. The criteria for judging in this round was stating the right facts, humour, word per minute and the engagement of the audience.

The participant who feels that any of his/her lines is done, then the group leader tally their bingo sheet. If the participant got their line done then they compete for remaining lines and full house otherwise strike 1 is given to that participant. And the game goes on this way and finally at the end the one participant from each group who had crossed all the columns mentioned in the sheet was declared as winner for round 1.



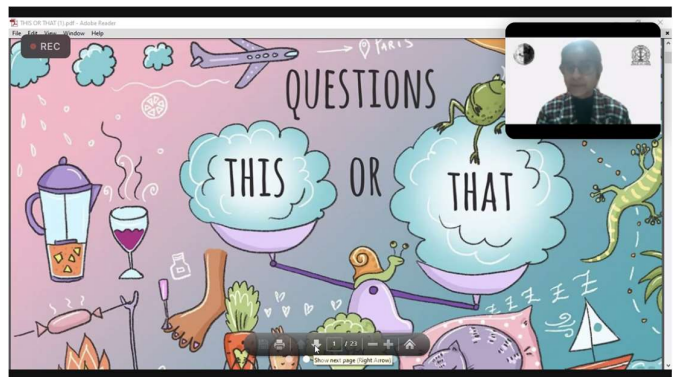
- ROUND 2: STARS GAMBLE

This was an Auction round having Bollywood and as well as Hollywood lead and supporting actors. 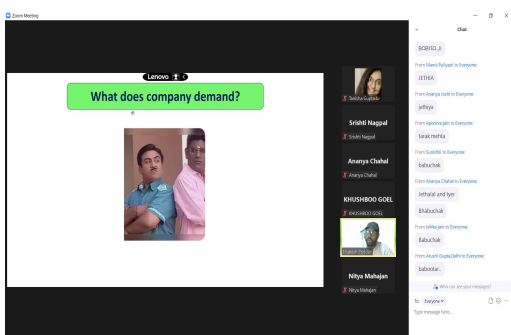
CLOSING CEREMONY

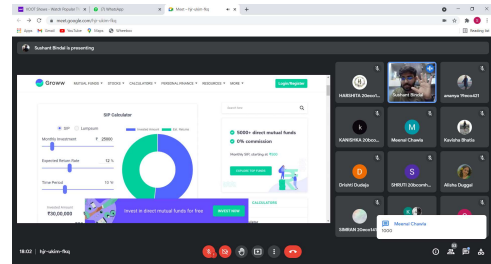

WEBINAR ON ALL ABOUT CRYPTOCURRENCY

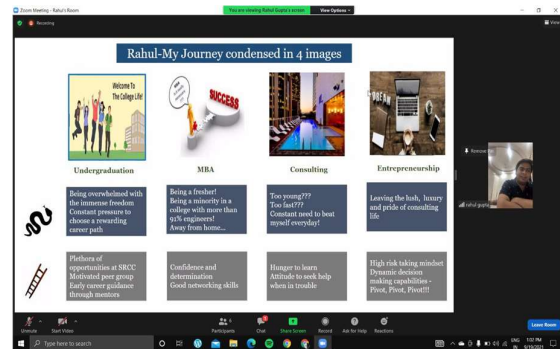
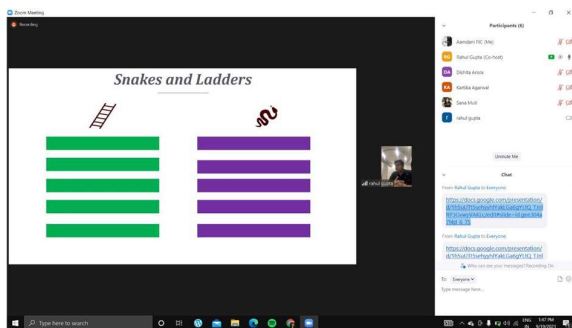

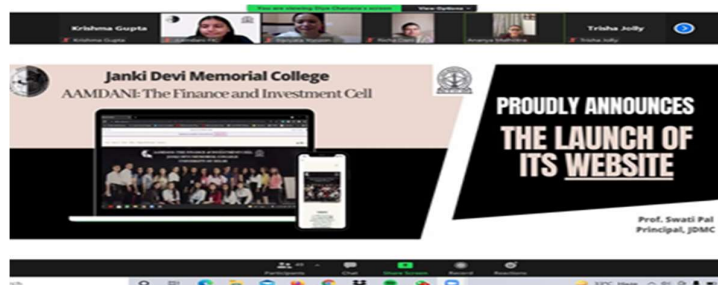

WEBSITE LAUNCH

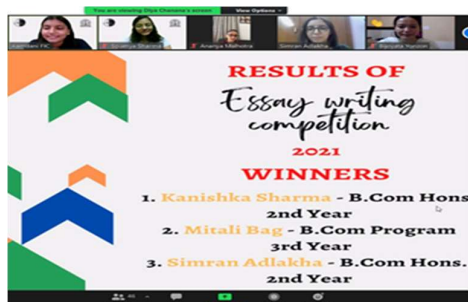

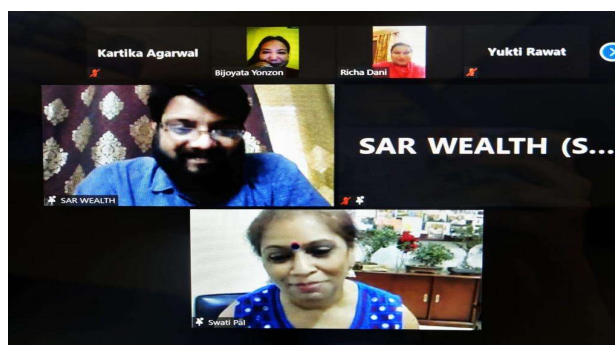
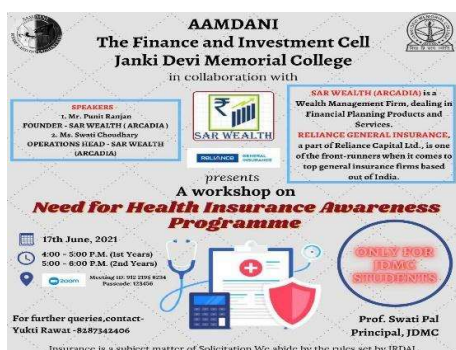
INDUSTRY READINESS PROGRAM
