**About the Society**

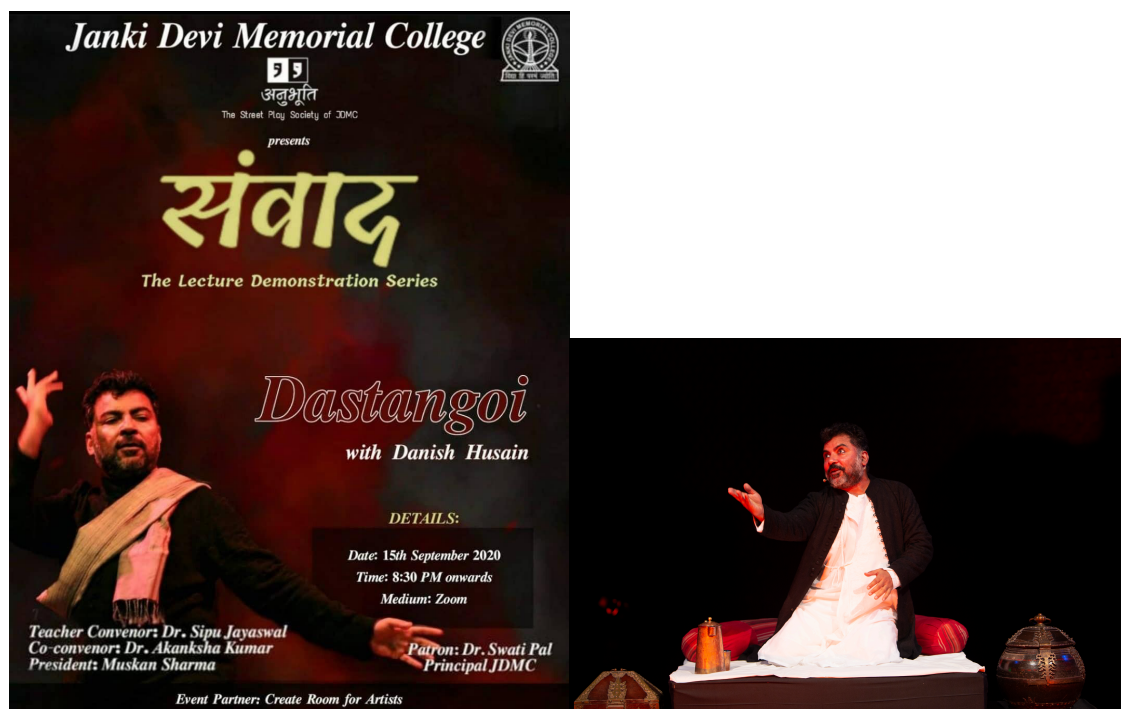
"Acting is nothing more or less than playing. The idea is to humanize life & ANUBHUTI tries to achieve that."

## Report 2020-21

Danish Husain sir is an actor, poet, storyteller, and a theater director who has been awarded with the Mahindra Excellence in Theater Award and Ustad Bismillah Khan Yuva Puruskar.

It was one such beam that lit hope in lives of 42 students of Pre and Primary School of Pipaltar village, district Pithoragarh, Uttarakhand. The initiative focused on holistic development of young minds and for the same various items like stationery kits, notebook sets, story books, lunch boxes & water bottles, solar lamps, first aid kits, hygiene kits, sports items, scholarships to students & teaching kits were provided to boost the little shining stars and promote quality education in and around the school. 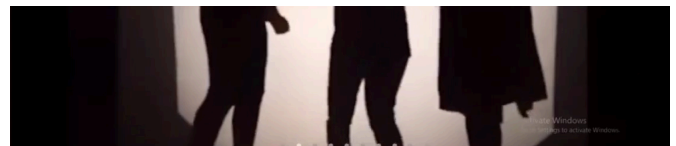
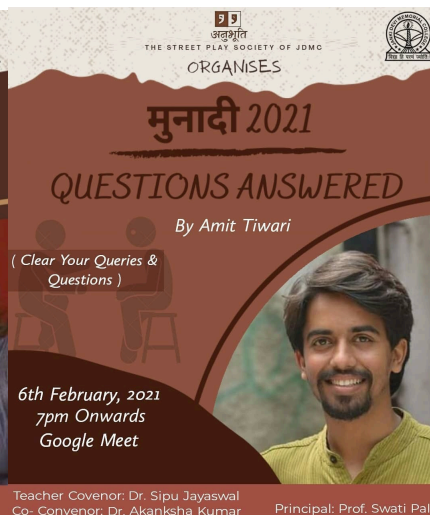
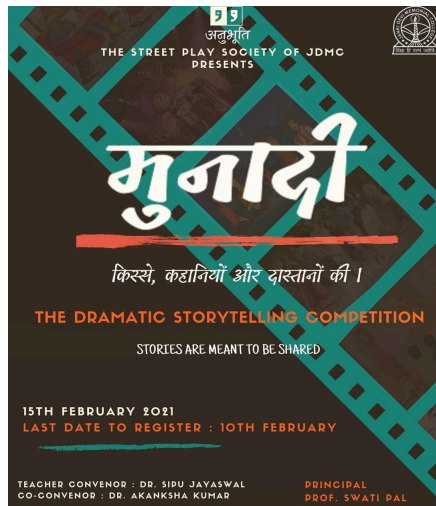

To begin with, a fun series of theater workshops was organised for the students, developmental activities included: physical and mental agility building activities, motor and soft skill development activities and various artistic activities. Keeping this in mind Anubhuti worked on the beautification of Pre and Primary School, Pipaltar village, district Pithoragarh, Uttarakhand.
