




Create From Waste-January 12, 2023

The students found the session extremely insightful and enriching. The students and faculty members in the college also submitted the e-waste brought by them at the collection point in the college campus.






Training and E-Waste Collection Drive-November 2, 2022




Workshop on Bathroom Hygiene and Use- September 14, 2022

National Webinar On Tiger Conservation
