
Sh. Jacques started by welcoming all the present officers and then went on to acquaint us with the spirit and purpose of the VAF. It is an initiative by the

Among the key issues discussed are:

- b) the NO is the convenor to plan out several activities related to VAF which includes interaction with staff about matters related to election
- c) NVSP is the official portal of the EC to check, register and verify the voter's list
- d) the local ELO/BLO is the nodal officer to deal with matters related to registration of names in the voter's list
- e) this time the VVPAT (Voter –Verified Voter Audit Trail) machine has been introduced in order to make elections more fair
- f) each voter should be cognizant about the electoral process
- g) interactive session, quiz, games, nukkad nataks maybe conducted in organisations in order to generate interest among voters
- h) seminars maybe conducted to impart information about the electoral process, parliamentary session, the Constitution of India, ballot paper, election and the process of election and so on
- g) we should have knowledge about our candidate/s
- h) this time the EC has ensured that the booths be disabled friendly, prior information about person/s with disabilities is to be given to the local booth officer so that adequate measures are taken
- i) importance of NOTA
- j) the ERO of the local area maybe invited to give further information about the election process








Conference room for inauguration of VAF at DM's office, Dariyagunj

The Principal, teaching, non-teaching staff and the students together took the Voter's pledge.


Events were conducted- Snakes and Ladders and Quiz related to the Electoral process and the Constitution of India.
