
Description:


About the Speaker:

Description:

The Department of Political Science, organised a National Quiz Competition in honour of the 73rd Republic Day. Teams from universities from all over the country participated in it. It was a two day long competition. It started on 24th January, 2022 and ended on 25th January, 2022. The event started with a welcome speech by our Association Incharge Mrs. Khachungla Chahang. There were 25 teams who had registered and out of which, 16 have turned up for the 1st round on 24th of January. Each team consisted of two members. Round 1 was Rapid Fire round in which, the questions were given on Google Form and each team was given 80 seconds to answer and submit their responses. Among the 16 team, only 9 teams qualified for the second round. The following Round 2 consisted of questions related to general knowledge about India. Out of 9 teams, 6 teams made it to the final round Day-1 of the competition was full of enthusiastic participation and was rich with knowledge.

Final round was held on the other day - 25th of January, with 6 qualified teams. This round was divided into three parts - Normal Q/A round, Prominent Personalities round and Audio Visual round. Each team was asked 4 questions in first part, 2 questions in second as well as in the third part. The final round was packed with healthy competition, increased gravity of the questions and say-ricketing adrenaline levels of the participants. After calculating the grand total of all the 3 parts of the round, out of 6 teams, only 3 teams came out to be the winners.

The winning teams were - Quizzards (1st place), Snoopy Searchers (2nd place) and Team Titans (3rd place). Participants were enthusiastic throughout the event.

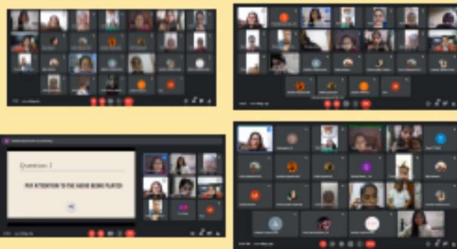

Maternity Benefit Act,1861- This act regulates the employment of women and maternity benefits mandated by law. It states that a woman employee who has worked in an organisation for a period of at least 80 days during the 12 months preceding the date of her expected delivery is entitled to receive maternity benefits, which includes maternity leave, nursing breaks, medical allowance, etc.



