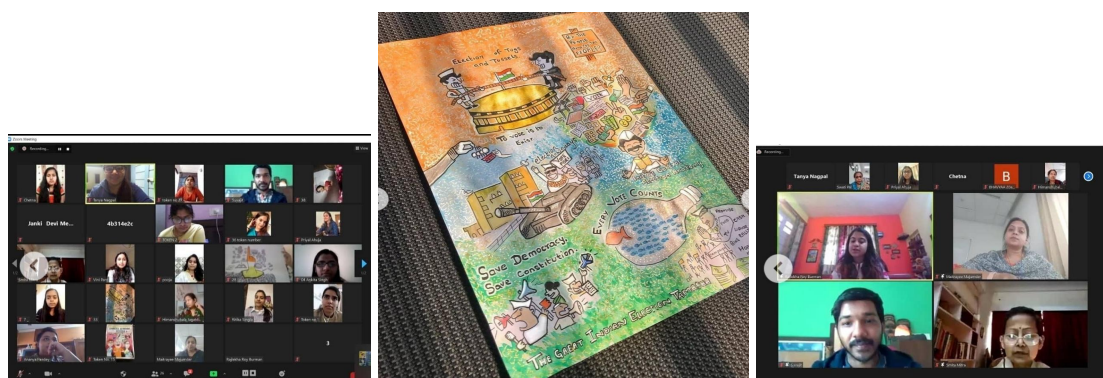
## 1. online inter college poster making competition

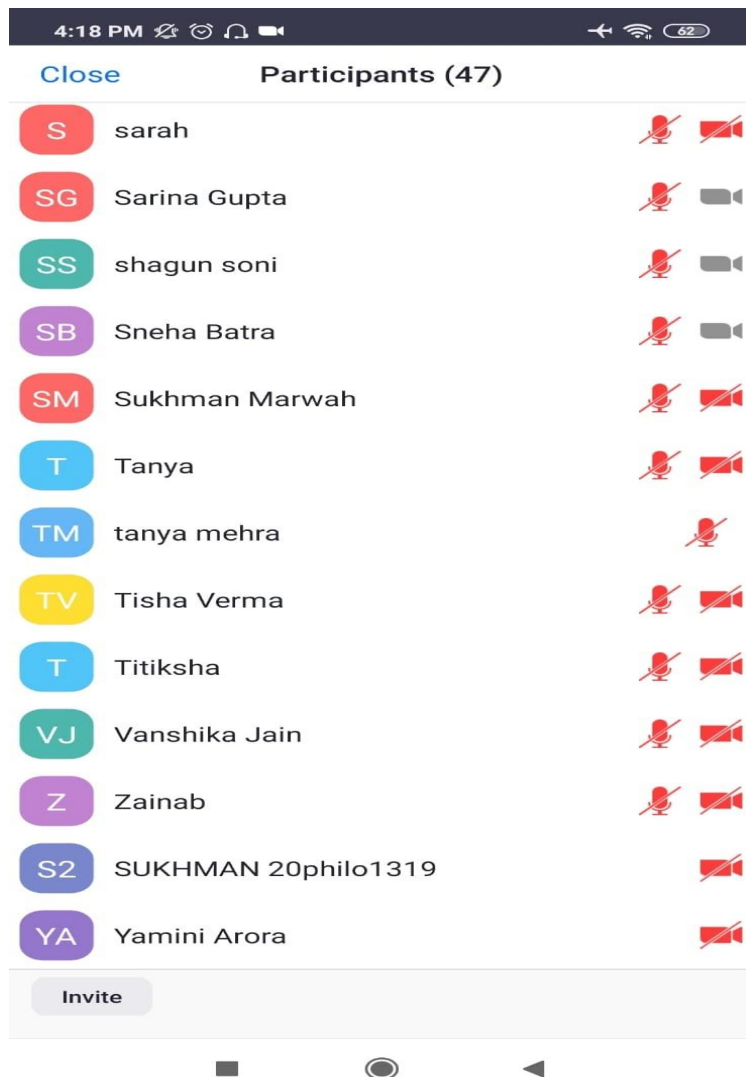
## **7. KNIFE PAINTING WORKSHOP**

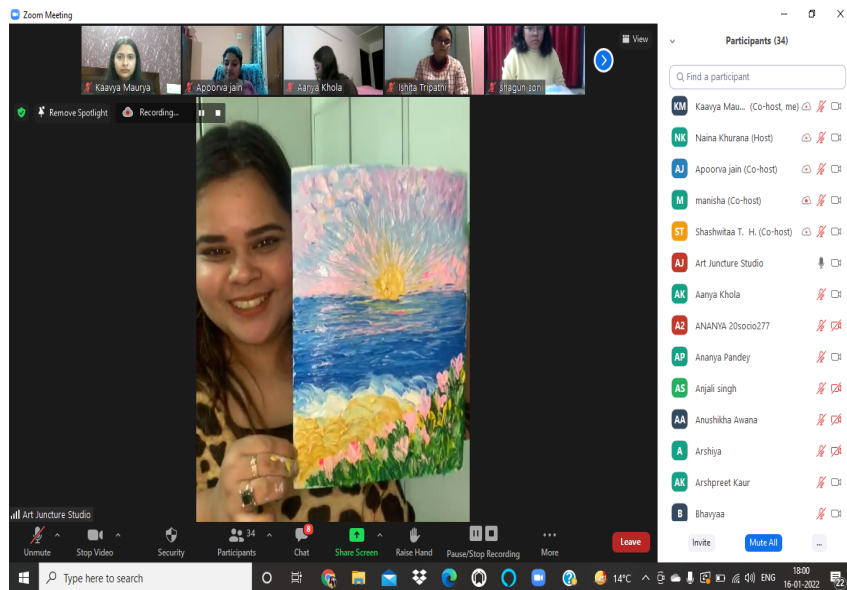

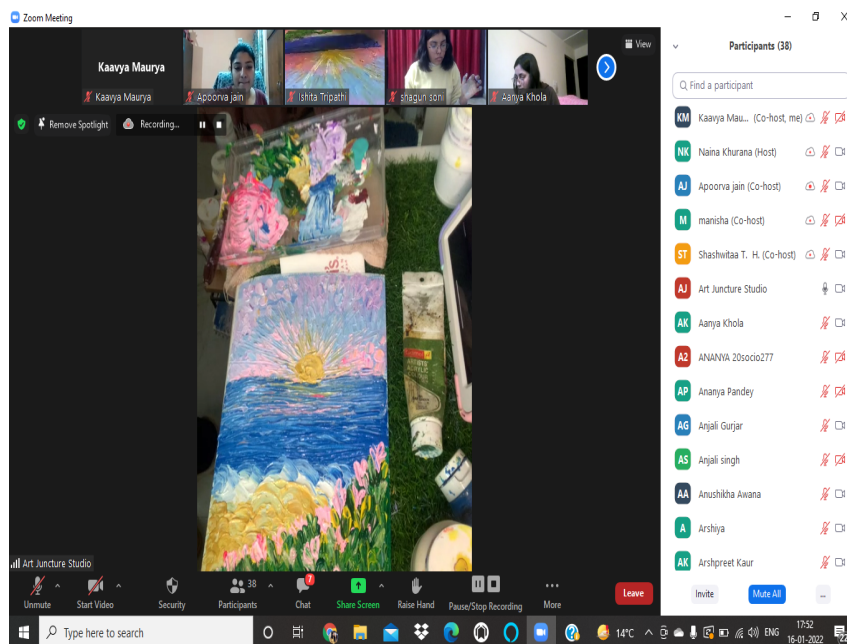

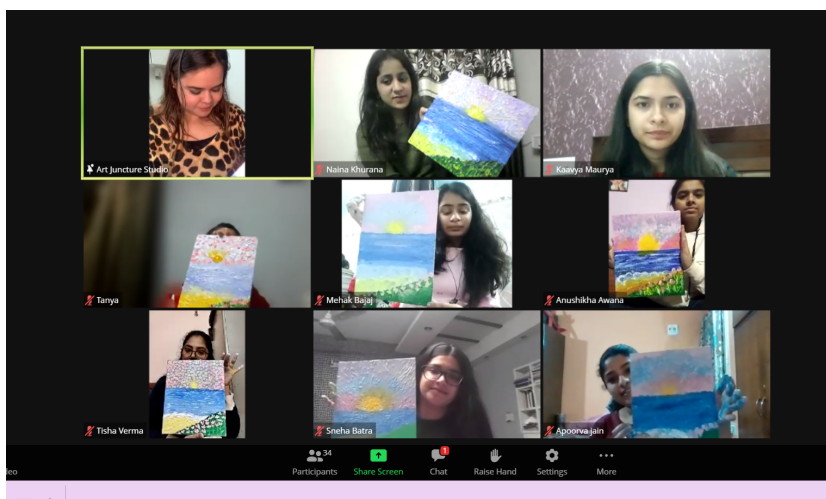
