#### **HIGHLIGHTS**




<u>Day 3:</u> The basic layout of the artwork was completed; the mentor continued to guide the participants about the techniques they can adopt to finish the artworks neatly.

Date: 19th October 2022 Time: 11 am onwards Venue: College Campus



Dr. Debahuti Brahmachari (Assistant Professor in Political Science at JDMC) and Mr Saksham (a student at Pantnagar University) were the judges for the competition. The participants assembled in the seminar room and a little introduction was played out for them —with the rules of the competition laid out again. Themes like 'Goblin', 'No Eyes', 'Deserted Research Centre' etc. were given to the participants before the competition; they had to choose any 3 colors of any medium and let their imagination on the theme flow. They were given a total of 2 hours and 30 minutes to complete their artworks and give the final touch-ups/write descriptions.

The event concluded with the creation of some beautiful artworks created with much sincerity and passion. The results were announced through the club's official Instagram page. Minakshi Roy of Sir JJ Institute of Applied Arts won the first prize whereas Pallavi V. Nair of Delhi Technological University bagged the second; Harshit Agarwal of Delhi Technological University stood third, and Kriti Anvesha of Indraprastha College for Women earned a 'special mention' from the judges. #### 5. Orientation 2022
