The event showcases the work of our members and allows the visitors to engage with the beautiful photo stories and also buy some of our wonderful prints for home.

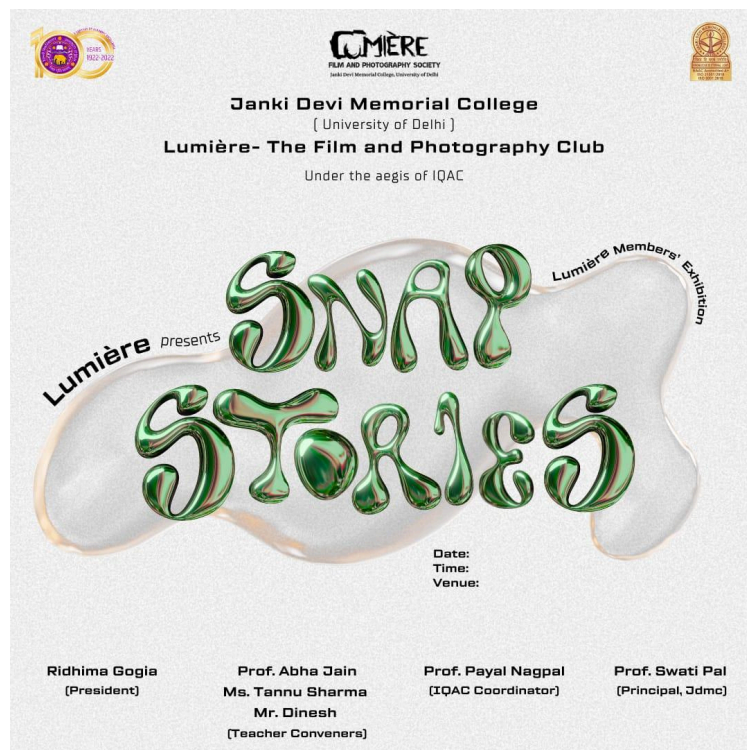
It was a wonderful experience, with various visitors over the course of two days.

The much awaited - 'On The Spot' Photography Competition, presents an excellent opportunity for all budding photographers to showcase their photography skills within a limited timeframe.

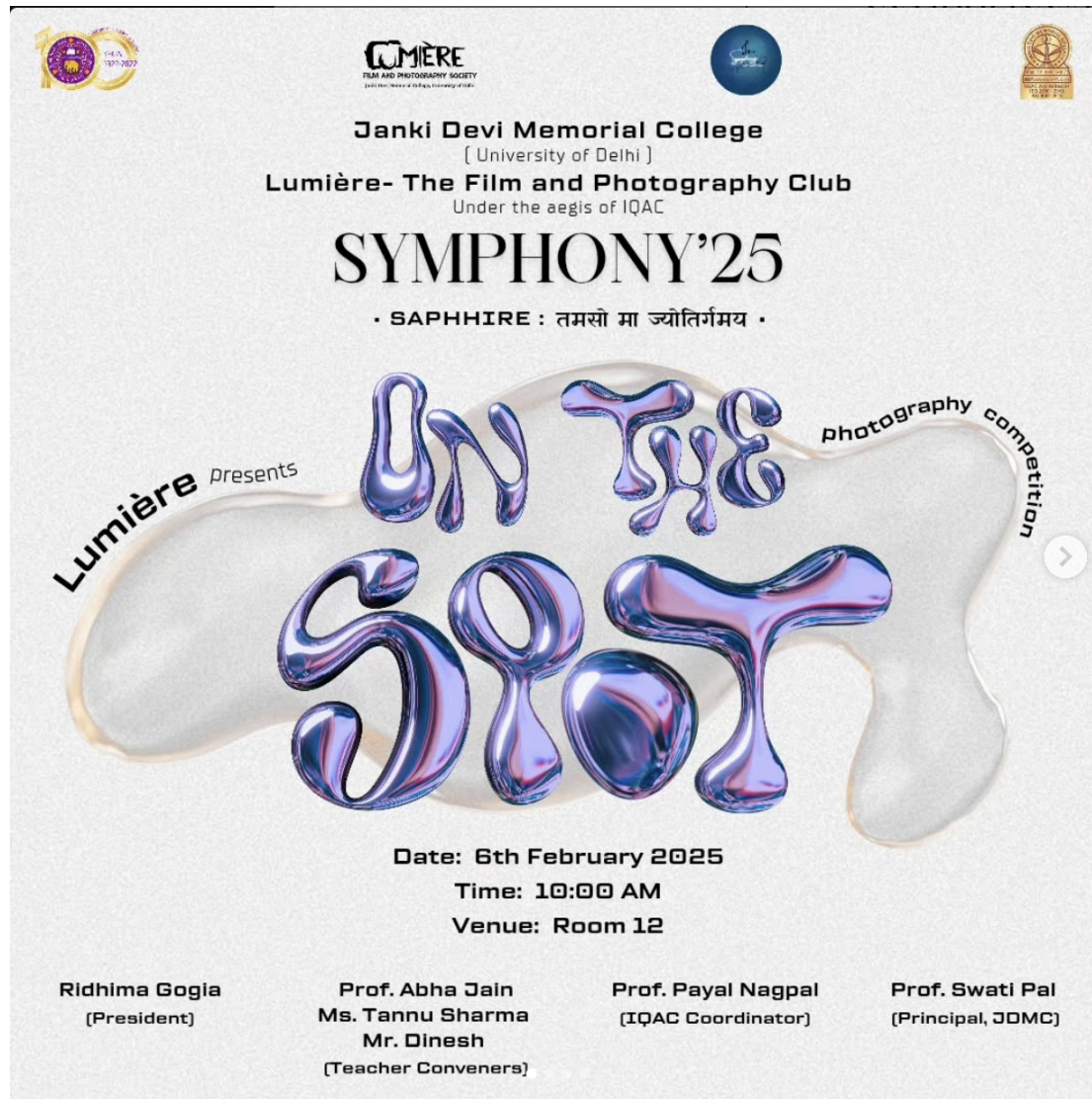

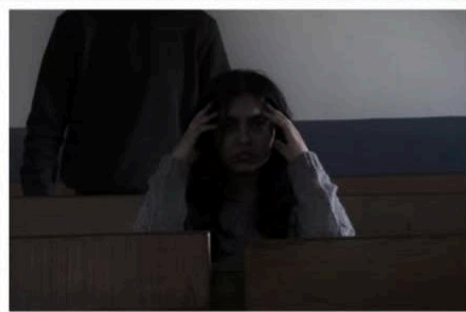

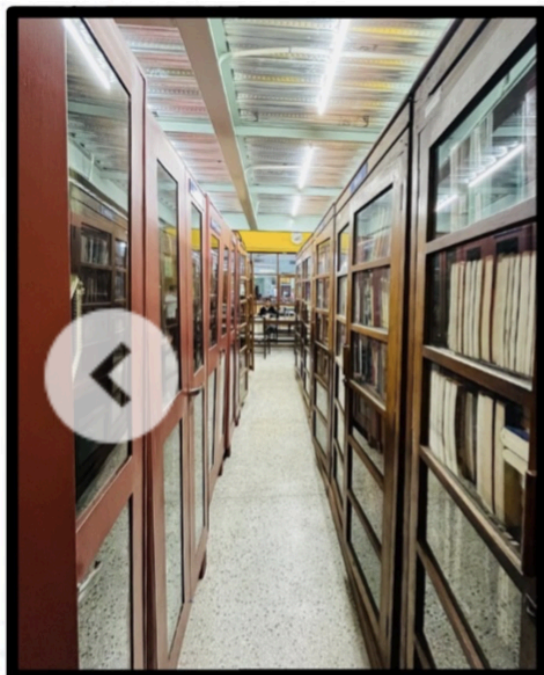
