





## 'Military Tattoo and Tribal Dance show '









### 'VISHWA DHARM SAMVAD'








#### **Numbers of students - 20**




Advance Leadership Camp was organized by 1UP Girls Battalion, Anand Engineering College, Agra from 14 December 2022 to 23 December 2022.


#### **Numbers of students - 120**

### 'International Conference'






Date of the event - 10th November 2022








### 'Ek Bharat Shreshtha Bharat Camp: Delhi Directorate'



# 'GARUDA: Life Story of Fighter Pilots'






#### Date of the event -13th October 2022
