## "All India Best Cadet competition- 2024"

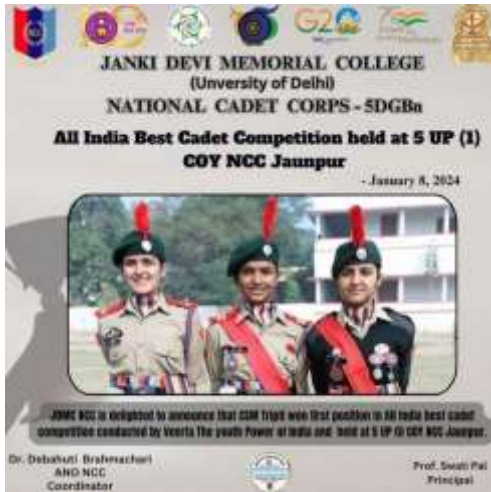


**Date of event - 8th January ,2024**

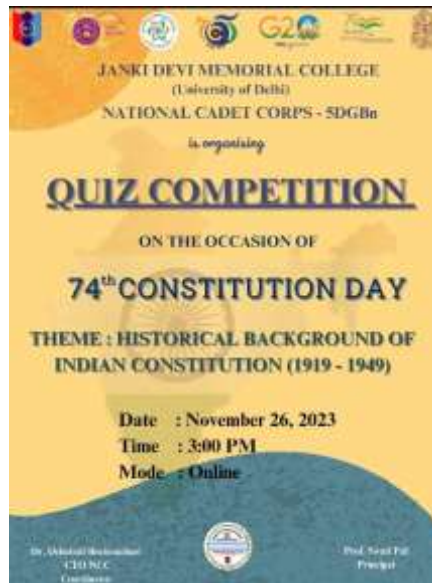

## ‘Veerangana Alumni series-Guard Training’



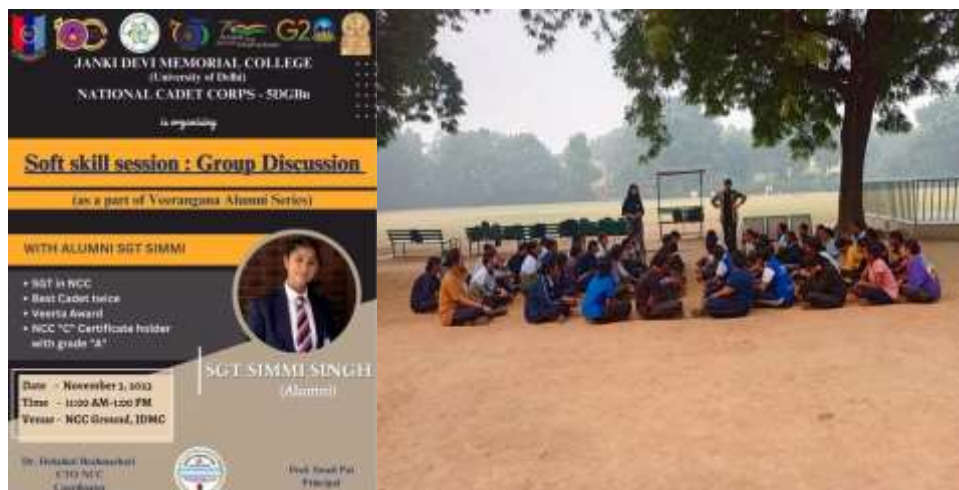

## "Disaster Management session"



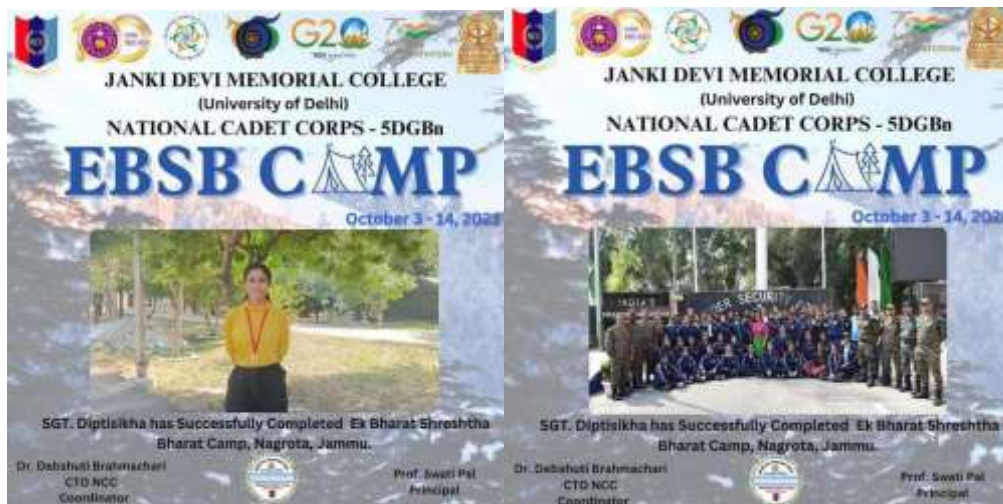
**Date of event -14th October ,2023**

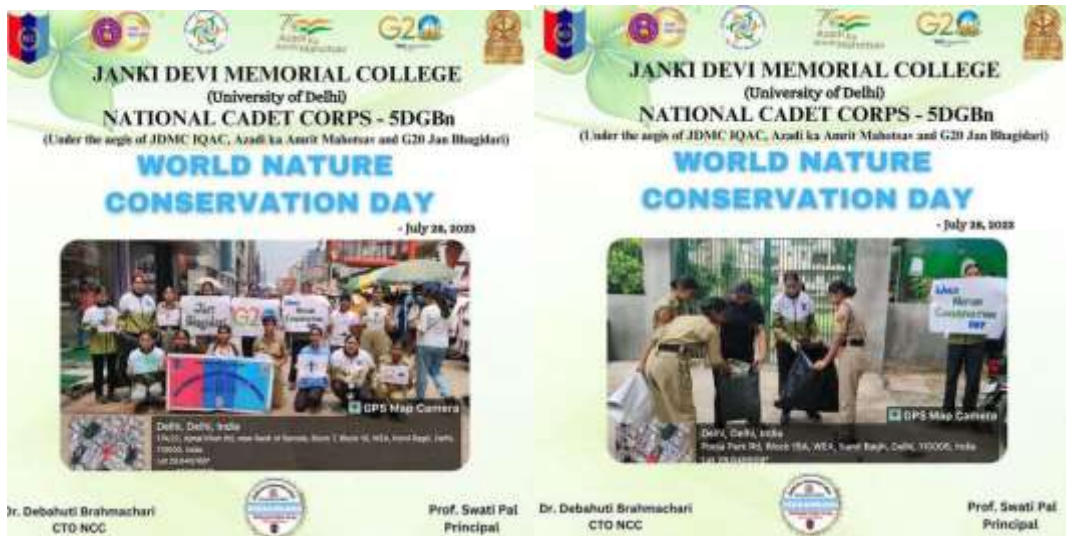

## 'JDMC NCC Academic Visit : Russian Cultural Centre'



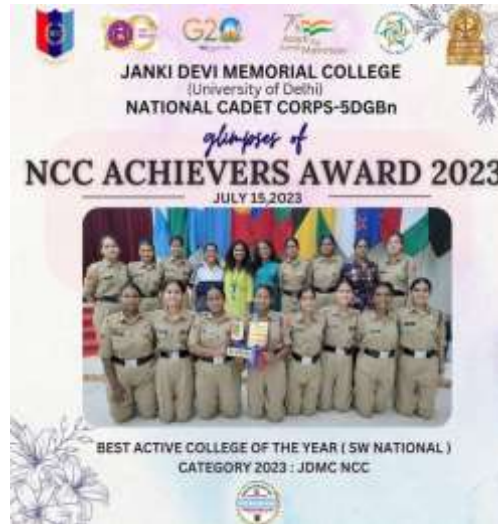

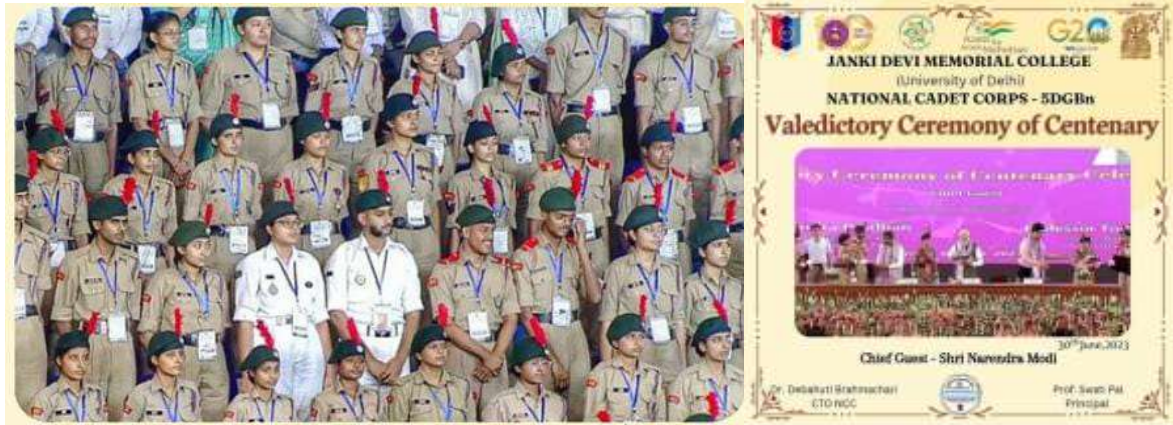

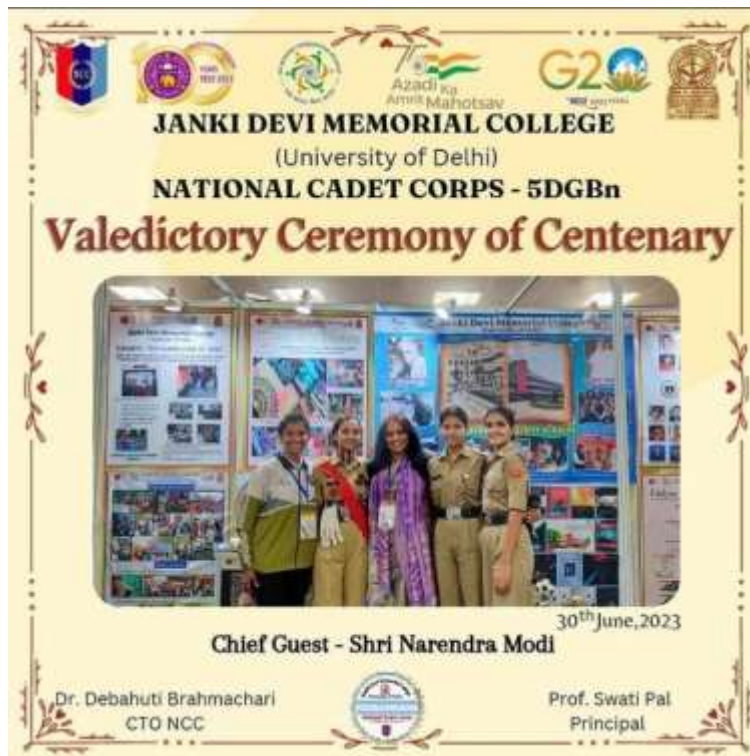
# 'DU Centenary Celebration'

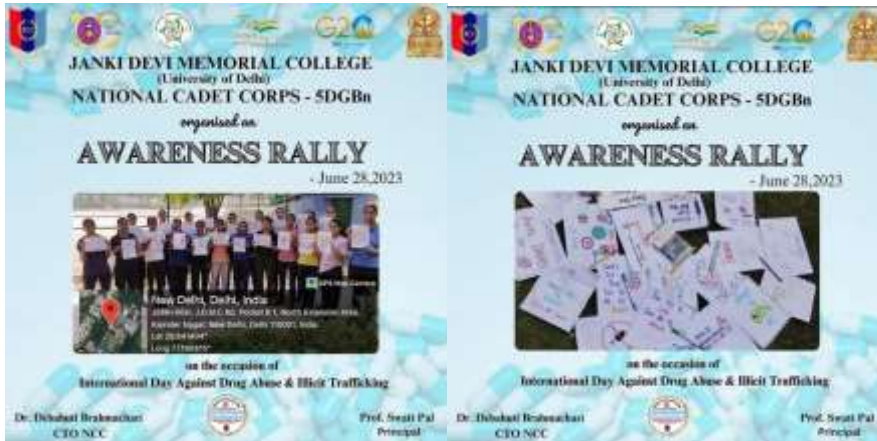

# ‘Blood Donation Camp- 2023’



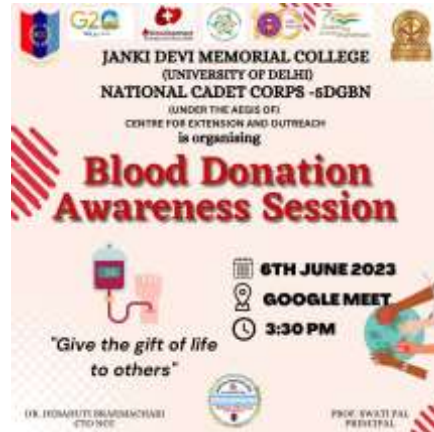
Date of event- 7th June,2023

## 'World Environment Day,2023'



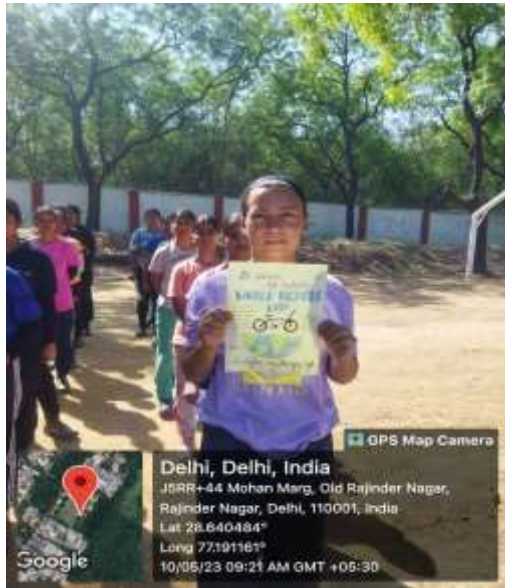
