# "Constitution Day"






DATE OF THE EVENT: 26th November, 2024

An online quiz competition was organised by JDMCNCC to celebrate the 'Constitution Day'.



**NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS: 95** 


'FRESHERS' on 4th October, 2024 on the theme of 'Bollywood'.



DATE OF THE EVENT: 22nd August, 2024


**NUMBER OF PARTICIPANTS: 15**
