
## Report of 2019 – 20

**7TH - 8TH August 2019 -**

### 1ST SEPTEMBER 2019

On 1st september NSS, JDMC volunteers went near the jhandewalan slum area where they indulged themselves with students by playing games and teaching them things in the form of games. On the same day, volunteers went to Noida sector 18 and taught people about the importance of cleanliness and recycling by distributing them reusable bags as plastic is dangerous to the environment.



### 9TH SEPTEMBER 2019

On 9th September 2019, the NSS Cell of JDMC had a Debate Competition on Gandhian Thoughts to celebrate 150 years of Gandhi Ji. The event started with two students singing the songs in respect to Gandhi ji's thoughts and his teachings. Students from different departments participated in the competition. Being a bilingual debate, students presented their thoughts in both Hindi and English. Students focused on different scenarios, like Satyagraha, Non-violence.

The main focus was how much the thoughts of Gandhi ji are vanishing these days and what can we do to bring them back. Dr. Rajinder Kumar, hon'ble judge of the competition presented his meaningful words in front of the students, teaching them on how Gandhian thoughts are beneficial and important.


