The programme concluded with a vote of thanks, encouraging the fresh volunteers to actively participate in NSS activities and contribute positively to society. The orientation programme was

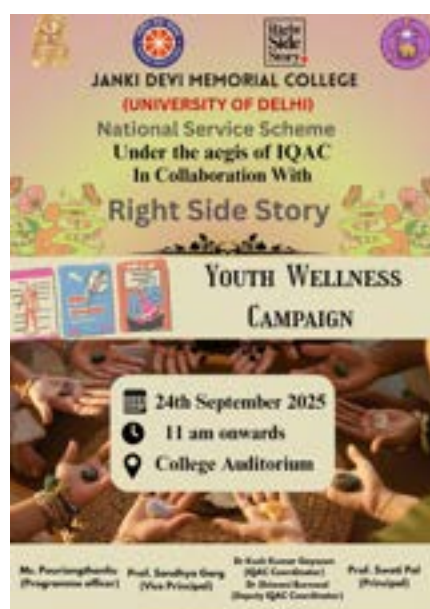
informative and inspiring, and it helped the new volunteers understand the significance of NSS in nation-building.
