
Celebration of Vigilance week

some advice and suggestions to become more effective debators. All the students were


enthusiastic and participated with great zeal. The competition also provided the newly enrolled

first years with an opportunity to access different opinions and viewpoints as well as display


their talent.


The Judge, Dr. Navpreet Kaur, addressing the Audience during the Conventional Debate Competition held on 4 November 2022 to commemorate Vigilance


